

## LUKE TUCHSCHERER TO RELEASE "LIVING THROUGH HISTORY" ON CLUBHOUSE RECORDS ON 13 JUNE

**BEDFORD, ENGLAND, 15th April 2025:** Luke Tuchscherer, the critically acclaimed singer/ songwriter, is to release his sixth album on Clubhouse Records on Friday 13th June.

The new album, *Living Through History*, is a hard-rocking, politically charged record produced by Luke's longtime collaborator David Banks.

Luke said: "You often hear people complain that there's no protest music any more. Well, I don't think that was ever true anyway, but this one is certainly a protest album!

"The last two records I've made have been acoustic affairs, so it's been great to get back to the rockier side of my music on this one. And I couldn't have picked a better person to help make it — Dave and I have known each other since we were kids and we've played together for years."

David Banks said: "The album is honest, diverse and full of righteous anger. I'm so excited for people to hear this record."

The album was mastered by Seattle music legend Jack Endino, who worked with artists such Nirvana, Soundgarden, Mudhoney and Mark Lanegan.

Luke said: "Anyone who knows me, knows I'm a huge fan of the 90s Seattle bands, so to have Jack Endino master this album was absolutely massive for me. And he did an amazing job!"

Although he now lives back in Bedford, Luke said the majority of the songs were written during his time in New York City.

"It's the first time I've made an album where all the songs came from the same period, as opposed to picking songs from my backlog to fit a certain theme. This time the theme just presented itself."

There are songs about capitalism ("Living Through History", "Whose Side Are You On?", "This World is Worth Saving"), workers' rights ("Gonna Be a Reckoning"), and a visceral, expletive-laden attack on racists and the purveyors of the culture war ("You Should Be Ashamed"). But for fans of Luke's ballads, there is space on the album for those too ("Walls Come Tumbling", "Goodbye, Bergen St").

Danny Tipping, co-founder of Clubhouse Records, said: "'This is Luke at his combative best. It's no-holds-barred rock'n'roll with uncompromising lyrics and guitars raging just as hard. It's a thrilling album for fans of old school Americana."

A single, "Gonna Be a Reckoning", will be released on Friday 18th April, which is the same day the album will be made available for pre-order on Bandcamp.

Luke Tuchscherer & The Penny Dreadfuls will be playing a special album launch show at the Sound Lounge in Sutton, London on Friday 4th July.
